

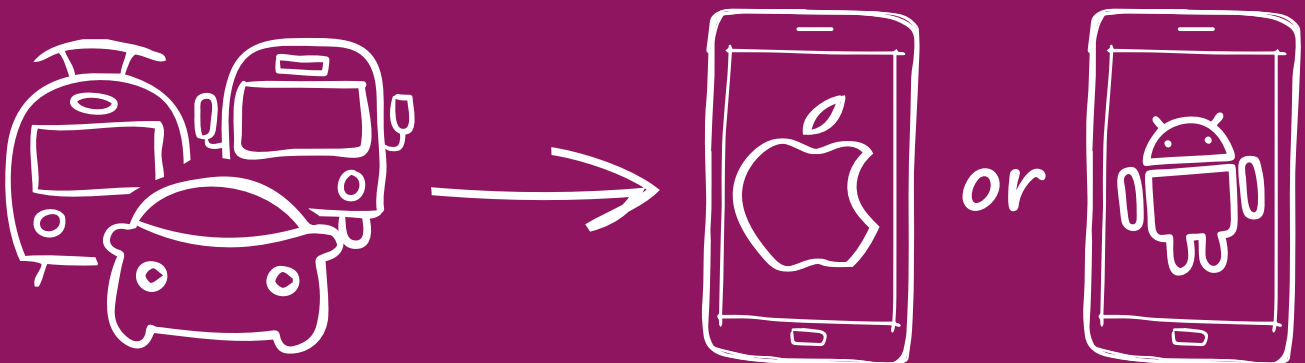

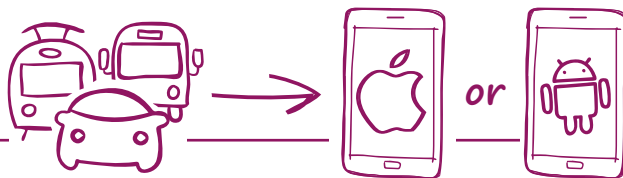

HOW?

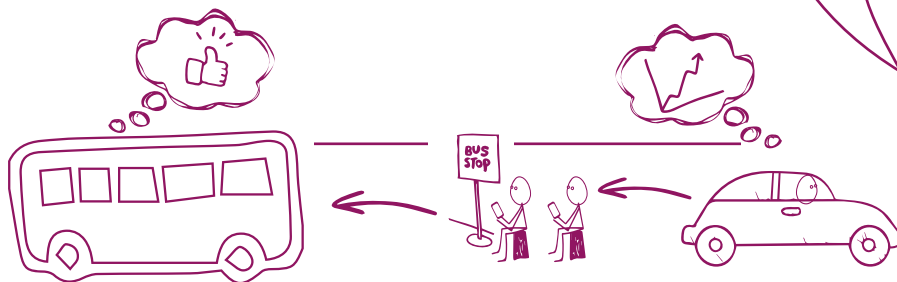
